




























Head of Primary's Message

Dear Parents,

Centre for Musical Arts is proud to bring instrumental music lessons to students in Year 4 - 6 (to begin with) at Dubai International Academy, Emirates Hills. We are delighted to invite you to register your children for instrumental music lessons in school with CMA. This letter contains important information regarding the registration process. Please read all of the information, as well as our Terms and Conditions document at the end of the registration form. Full details can be found on our website at www.cmadubai.com or on the registration form via the link below:

Dubai International Academy, Emirates Hills; https://forms.gle/EkGAHZeKJfBmoR5B6 We will be offering lessons on a variety of instruments which will be available subject to availability and demand. The list of possible instruments can be found on our registration form.

Our lessons are 30 minutes in length and take place during the school day. Timetables are on a rotation, so each week the lesson time will change. Please be aware that lessons do occur during classroom lesson times and your child will be taken out of classroom lessons in order to attend their instrumental lesson.

We also offer group lessons for selected instruments. There is a maximum of 2-4 students per group which will be for beginners only. After one year of learning, students will be encouraged to move on to individual lessons. Group lessons are only available to absolute beginners. Lesson fees are Dhs 165 per individual lesson and Dhs 100 per student in a group (maximum 2-4 students) and are chargeable by the term. (Subject to availability). Fees must be paid before the lessons commence. Please note that your booking is not confirmed until fees have been settled. Invoices will be sent upon receipt of registration. All lessons are subject to availability and demand.

We look forward to welcoming you to our instrumental programme.






