

As per KHDA regulations, children in Year 2-6 sit the NGRT reading test 3 times per year. The first assessment will take place in classrooms over the course of next week. The New Group Reading Test (NGRT) is a standardised assessment to measure reading skills of students aged 5-16 years against the UK national average. NGRT tests not just the ability of students to decode what they read, but also to comprehend and apply meaning.

As well as NGRT, students in Years 3-6 will also complete the CAT4 assessment, which is a cognitive test to assess student potential and identify areas of aptitude.

There is no revision necessary as we would like our students to be relaxed and calm when they take these tests.

Students will be taking the assessment on school laptops but please send your child with a set of wired headphones with a jack similar to these or these.
