The Class of 2018 proved to be outstanding with 16 students attaining 40 and above points. Paulomi Sengupta, our valedictorian, achieved the IBDP top score of 45/45. This is indeed a rare achievement as only less than 1% of the IBDP student population worldwide achieve such outstanding results. The cohort moved our overall grade point average to 34 points which is excellent achievement. Congratulations to each and every one of our 2018 DP graduates and wishing them every success for the future.





### MESSAGE FROM THE IBMYP COORDINATOR MYP STUDENTS RECEIVE EASSESSMENT RESULTS


The MYP team at Dubai International Academy are proud to announce a significant improvement in our MYP results. This year we had 128 students registered for the May 2018 examination session and we maintained our steady progress in increasing our MYP Certificate student grade average from 41 points to 42 points out of 56 respectively. Impressively, we gained a 10% jump in our overall student pass rate moving from 86% of students passing the MYP Certificate to an impressive 96% pass rate. Our subject results reflect these improvements with DIA having subject averages above world averages in 16 out of 21 subjects with a highly respectable subject average grade moving from 5.05 to 5.22 out of a total of 7 marks.

A final note of congratulations to our joint top achievers; Tamara Hassan Khudair, Candice Saxod and Sarah Sherif Khattab whom scored a highly commendable 52/56 points respectively. Congratulations again to the wonderful MYP results of the Class of 2018!




