

Dear Primary School Community,



Head of Secondary Message




Dear all,







Co-Curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities form an integral part of the DIA school community and we will continue to enhance the depth and quality of these.

CCAs are planned to begin in Week beginning 12th September. Please await further communication regarding the options and sign up procedure.



Dress Code

- Students should wear the regulatory school uniform with black shoes and the uniform can be seen <u>here</u>.
- Students should bring their full PE kit to school when there is a PE class on the same day and use the changing facilities. The only exception is on Friday, Years 10 and 11 can attend school in their PE kit.
- Students should make a special point of keeping personal hygiene at the highest possible level regular washing of hair, keeping nails clean, along with consistent washing and sanitising hands.
- For safeguarding reasons, IDs and lanyards are compulsory. Should a student require a replacement during the year, this can be issued via the Secondary

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School Office at a cost of AED 20. Students new to school can upload their picture using the link <u>here</u>. They will be given out during the first week.

Student lockers

- All students will be allocated a locker on their first day. It will be their responsibility to keep this clean, not leave any food in there longer than a day and not graffiti it at all.
- Students must bring in their own small padlock to secure the locker.





Timetabling & Homeroom

- Student timetables will be live on the ISAMS portal on Sunday, 28 August. This will include their homeroom.
- There are 7 lessons in the day with a duration of 55mts per lesson. There is a 20 minutes break and a 40 minutes lunch during the day.

Registration

- The registration period is from 7:30am 7:40am and takes place in the homerooms.
- Students can make their way to their homeroom from 7:15am. Any student arriving between 7am and 7:15am must remain in the canteen.
- Any student arriving to school after 7:30am will be recognised as late in the homeroom. If a student arrives after 7:40am must report to the SS office to sign in and

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pick up a late slip before proceeding to their lesson 1.Persistent lateness to school will result in a detention.Further details about the behaviour policy and expectations will be sent out in the next few days.

School Food

• Hot and cold food will be available from the school canteen.

• Cash or debit/credit card can be used to purchase the food in the first few weeks. This will give the new catering provider time to register the Student's ID card onto their system so money can be loaded onto this.

Technology

- DIA is a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) school and would provide Internet and storage space through the Microsoft platform. There will be a dedicated Technology session for new students during the orientation day to set up the various platforms.
- For Managebac, Microsoft TEAMS & Kognity (DP/CP), new students will obtain login details through their school email in the first week.
- Returning students will be provided with a reset password for the school network and Office login on Tuesday, 30 August. This is to ensure students choose a new password at the start of the academic year.

What to bring

- Students should bring:
 - **at least** one additional face mask.
 - Laptop.
 - Stationery including calculator
 - A padlock for their locker
 - Their school textbooks (can be kept in their locker)
 - Water bottle and food. Additional water is available in the vending machines (AED 1 coin) food can be purchased in the canteen.
 - Their own food and snack or money/credit/debit card to purchase food from the canteen.



Uniform

- Students should wear the regulatory school uniform with black shoes. The uniform can be seen <u>here</u>.
- PE Kit should be worn with non-marking trainers.
- On days where students have PE, Swimming and Dance, they should come in their PE kit, and will remain in it for the day.

We continue to be mindful of hygiene and encourage students to be clean and presentable.

Relevant specialist lessons will shared by your child's Homeroom Teacher as part of the Hopes and Dreams letter.
Specific timetabling information or questions should be directed to your children's Homeroom Teacher or Head of Year.

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Registration

- The registration period is from 7:30am 7:40am and takes place in the homerooms.
- Students can make their way to their homeroom from 7:15am. Any student arriving between 7am and 7:15am must remain in there assigned area.
- Register closes and lessons begin at 7:40. Please ensure your child has ample time to reach their classroom before this time.

Student Absence

- If your child is absent due to illness, please complete the <u>'Absence Notification Link'</u> before 08:00am of the day of the absence.
- If you are requesting leave for an extended period of time (3 or more days) submit the same form with reasons for the request. This will be subject to approval. We advise all non-essential travel plans be restricted to the prescribed holidays, so as not to impact on your



children's attendance record.

Food

- We are pleased to share that we have contracted Emirates Tastes for our school food this year.
- A letter detailing how to avail of this service will be shared shortly.
- If you choose to bring a snack and lunch from home please ensure this healthy and adequate to the needs of your children.


