



Art Competition Winners




DIA FEMSTEM Day









On Friday 12th May, our Year 7 to 9 FemPower students created a STEM fair that showcased their impressive scientific and technological knowledge through their own experiments and demonstrations. Nominated Year 6 girls, chosen for their interest and aptitude in STEMrelated learning, had a blast exploring the different exhibits and learning from the older students. The experiments were interesting and varied: electric circuits; edible DNA and stellar constellations (with sweets!); reactions with volcanoes and fire snakes; layering liquids; and making ice cream! The highlight of the day was the science bake-off challenge, where students from all year levels worked together to create delicious treats using scientific principles. 







Curtin University Dubai STEM Challenge!
