



A group of 5 senior students (Mehul Vemareddy District) Vemareddy, Prateeti Saran, Umar Ingalls, Soumyo Satyanarayanan, and Kshiteez Panigrahi) decided to reach for the sky their innovative ideas with by constructing an in-house lunar rover prototype from scratch as a part of the Maker's Movement—a popular engineering subculture in the US. Taking guidance from the Dubai Future Labs and UAE's Al Ministry, the students assembled their project in just 3 months.





Inspired by the NASA Artemis Mission, these seniors constructed a lightweight kart-like frame for the rover using pipes and connectors. The rover is electrically powered, and even has the capability to be remote controlled using a laptop. The students even built the rover accessories: a robotic arm to collect samples and a solar panel for renewable energy on the moon. Moving forward, they will even be integrating AI into the rover to allow for self-driving capabilities.
